## Tax Updates

#### Individual

Tax Projector is available in this release, including updates reflecting the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act.

#### Corporation

A new option is available to use the 2018 tax rate of 21% in computing estimated tax on Form 1120-W, Estimated Tax for Corporations. By default, we will continue to use current 2017 tax rates in calculating 2018 estimated tax. Should you decide to use the 2018 tax rate, select the new option on worksheet Payments/Penalties > Estimates and Application of Overpayment > Federal Estimates and Application of Overpayment > Use 2018 tax rate (Line 28), or Interview Form T-6, Box 56. In the event the calculated 2018 tax is less than the 2017 tax, a caution diagnostic will be generated alerting you to the potential of being underpaid in 2018.

## **Electronic Filing Updates**

#### Individual

We received a production schema from the IRS and will begin accepting returns in advance of the January 29, 2018, IRS open for Individual returns. Returns involving the pending extender legislation, the new medical expense rate, or other open items will continue to disqualify, but qualified returns can be uploaded and released, and will be transmitted to the IRS on January 29, 2018.

Should you decide to use the 2018 tax rate, select the new option on worksheet Payments/Penalties > Estimates and Application of Overpayment > Federal Estimates and Application of Overpayment > Use 2018 tax rate (Line 28), or Interview Form T-6, Box 56. In the event the calculated 2018 tax is less than the 2017 tax, a caution diagnostic will be generated alerting you to the potential of being underpaid in 2018.

#### **Power Pack**

The statement for Page 2, Question Q will no longer include foreign corporations that owned 50% or more of voting stock, directly or indirectly, at the end of the tax year.

## **District of Columbia**

#### Federal

A new option is available to use the 2018 tax rate in computing estimated tax on Form 990-W, Estimated Tax on Unrelated Business Income for Tax-Exempt Organizations. When Form 990-T is being filed as a corporation, a tax rate of 21% will be used. If filing Form 990-T as a trust, the 2018 trust rates will be used. By default we will continue to use current 2017 tax rates in calculating the 2018 estimated tax. Should you decide to use the 2018 tax rates, select the new option on worksheet Payments/Penalties > Estimates and Application of Overpayment > Estimate Preparation for Form 990-T > Force recalculation of estimated tax worksheet using next year rates, or Interview Form X-1, Box 40.
