New in this Release

IRS Fraud Prevention Initiatives

As a previously-announced part of the Internal Revenue Service state tax agencies and private-sector industry <u>Security Summit partnership</u>, we are now implementing taxpayer and tax return preparer safeguards for the upcoming 2017 filing season. These initiatives will enhance authentication efforts of tax return preparers via these new requirements:

- Mandatory logout after 30 minutes of inactivity
- Mandatory 24-hour logout regardless of activity
- "Bot" detection for each login to CCH Axcess
- Strong passwords with 8 characters minimum, including an uppercase letter, lowercase letter, special character and a number
- Mandatory password reset every 90 days

In addition to the IRS Fraud Prevention Initiatives mentioned above, Document users will also notice the following change:

When direct editing a file, you will be prompted to confirm activity after 25 minutes of inactivity in CCH Axcess, and will be logged out of CCH Axcess if there is no response within 5 minutes. If this happens, the direct-edited file must be manually checked back into Document.

CCH Axcess Document PDF Converter Driver Updated to Support Microsoft® Windows 10

The Document PDF Converter driver has been updated to add support for Microsoft[®] Windows 10. Users will no longer receive the "Printer not activated, error code -30" activation error when using the Document PDF Converter printer driver to convert them to PDF and save to Document.
