2014 Tax Updates

Tax Increase Prevention Act (TIPA) Update

The IRS continues to release forms affected by TIPA, commonly known as *Tax Extenders*, and we have updated our tax programs accordingly. All Tax Extender forms have been updated by the IRS to reflect the revised text that replaces the *Reserved* caption used on earlier releases.

Maine Conformity/Nonconformity with the Tax Increase Prevention Act of 2014

Based on recent communication from Maine Revenue Services, indicating that conformity is planned, CCH Axcess Tax has been updated to conform with recent changes to Maine tax forms for paper and electronic filing. Form 3115. If automatic change code 997 is entered on Form 3115, the filing instructions are updated to include Washington, D.C., in addition to Ogden, Utah.

State Transmittal Letter Customization. The paragraph instructing taxpayers to return state signature forms now allows for customization. In order for customization to flow properly, the Transmittal Letter > State Filing Instructions > Electronic Filing > paragraph 18, "[Return {StEForm} to {Us} {StEfrmDt}.]", must be reset and customized again.

The default values are loaded for the tax-exempt code on Interest (Schedule B) (Detail) > Tax Exempt Interest > Code and on Dividends (Schedule B) (Detail) > Tax Exempt Interest > Code when both tax-exempt interest and private activity bond interest have been entered on Interest (Schedule B) (Detail) > IRS 1099-INT > Tax-exempt interest and Specified private activity bond interest or on Dividends (Schedule B) (Detail) > IRS 1099-DIV > Exempt-interest dividends and Specified private activity bond interest dividends.

Kansas

For tax year 2014, the Kansas Department of Revenue requires the amounts on Schedule S, Part A, Lines A6 and A24, to match the amount on Form 1040, Line 17, instead of reporting entities with losses on Line A6 and reporting entities with income on Line A24. We have removed the statements detailing the entities and their amounts since the amounts on Schedule S, Part A, Lines A6 and A24, will match the total amount reported on Form 1040, Line 17.

The disqualifying diagnostic text matches the diagnostic heading for Kansas and does not produce an error when printing the tax return.

Electronic Filing

The processing of extensions with federal only PDF attachments is no longer stopped due to a PDF attachment error.

New York

The New York preparer exclusion code from the staff profile is now included in the return when using a preparer code in the return.

Filing instructions produced with Form NJ-630-V, composite extension payment voucher, have been clarified.
