Tax Updates

Hurricane Relief

Tax year 2016 Hurricane Relief updates are available for federal and affected states. The extended due date for those impacted by Hurricanes Harvey and Irma is January 31, 2018. Per IRS instructions for Form 4684, any 2016 returns claiming losses related to Hurricanes Harvey and Irma must be paper filed; these returns will remain disqualified, indefinitely.

Tax Cuts and Jobs Act

Those provisions of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act that apply to tax year 2016 fiscal filings, specifically bonus depreciation, are planned for Release 2016-5.4, scheduled for January 21, 2018.

Partnership and S Corporation

Michigan. 2017 Composite Forms 807, 1040H and MI-1041-ES are available for filing fiscal year tax returns.
