Highlights for Release 2017-6.1

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2017 Tax Updates

All Systems

Minnesota - Updates related to recent Minnesota legislation moving their date of conformity to December 31, 2018, are now available. All Minnesota returns that include values in fields labeled "this line intentionally left blank" or those calculated using releases prior to 2017-6.1 will be stopped by CCH.

Tax Product Updates

Individual (1040) Product Updates

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Minnesota

Minnesota has passed legislation which moves their date of conformity to 12/31/2018. Form and program updates received from Minnesota will be available in the release version 2017-6.1. Any Minnesota returns calculated using a version of the software older than 2017-6.1 or have values in fields which have been labeled "this line intentionally left blank" will be rejected by Minnesota.

Updates available on this release:

- Schedule M-15 Underpayment of Estimated Income Tax will not be required if tax after allowable credits is less than \$1,000, updated from the previous rate of \$500.
- Schedule M1LT1 Long-Term Care Insurance Credit has had the AGI threshold percentage on Line 3 updated to 7.5% to match what the federal threshold percentage is for medical expenses.
- These lines have been labeled "this line intentionally left blank". Nothing will be computed and input will not flow to these lines.
 - Schedule KF Line 8, Schedule KS Line 8, and Schedule KPI Line 8
 - Schedule M1NC Lines 1 3
 - Schedule M1NC Lines 5 8
 - Schedule M1NC Lines 10 and 11
- Schedule M1NC, Line 9 will equal Line 4 instead of Lines 3 through 8.
- Schedule M1NC, Lines 12 and 14 will no longer include a calculation concerning a charitable contribution limitation. Line 12 is now only mortgage insurance premiums deducted on Federal Schedule A. Line 14 is now only deferred foreign income included on federal return. The amount included in the federal return will automatically be included.
- Schedule KF Line 16, Schedule KS Line 10, and Schedule KPI Line 10 were previously subtractions due to federal changes not adapted by Minnesota. These lines are now only for Section 965 deferred foreign income. New input has been added for this amount that will also carry to M1NC Line 14.
- Schedule M1M Line 5 worksheet for federal bonus depreciation addition no longer contains an adjustment on Line 3 for an amount from M1NC Line 1.

S Corporation (1120S) Product Updates
