Tax Updates

We continue to update our programs related to tax extender provisions as information is received. The IRS is in the process of updating their forms, instructions, and electronic filing system; final versions of these forms have not been received in time for this release:

Form 8844	Form 8910
Form 8864	Form 8915
Form 8900	Form 8917

Schedule A and Form 6251 are now available for Individual electronic filing.

Form 4136 is now available for Individual, Corporation, and S Corporation electronic filing.

The Corporation and S Corporation late filing penalty increased. The late filing penalty for filing a return more than 60 days late is now the lesser of \$435 or 100% of the tax due.

S Corporation

Roll Forward Update is available to update Roll Forward of the following fields on Federal > General > Return Options > Processing Options. These were previously rolled forward into incorrect boxes. Roll Forward will be updated on a future release.

- Last four digits of SSNs on Form 1125-E
- Return summary and tax balance summary option
- Suppress calculation history report
- Print state tax deduction schedule
- Print Sec.163(j) election statement for Schedule K-1

Electronic Filing Updates

Individual

Electronically filed returns uploaded prior to the IRS open date of January 27 should be released timely so as not to expire due to the 10-day rule. This requirement has been extended to include most state returns for tax year 2019.

Michigan Cities non-Detroit electronically filed returns will stop on releases prior to release 2019-2.4, scheduled for February 2, 2020, due to recently announced filing requirements. These returns will need to be recalculated and resubmitted on release 2019-2.4.

If Federal 4868 prints, Form 1000F/1000NR "Check this box if you have filed a state extension or an automatic federal extension" will be checked.

North Carolina

North Carolina TEC form, Lines 5 and 7 foot correctly.

North Carolina Electronic Filing

Last four digits of bank account appears in the letters and filing instructions.

An accountant entered postscript will be included on the extension letter when sequencing is entered for standard, special, or accountant prepared paragraphs.

Form 8916-A, Part III, Line 4, Other Interest Expense, now includes Floor Plan Financing Interest Expense entered in Income/Deductions > Business > Deductions > Floor Plan Financing Interest Expense.

Other Income/Other Deduction items that have activity numbers tied to them will now be included on the Schedule M-3.
