Highlights for Release 2021-3.2.1

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Tax Updates

Individual

Alabama - Alabama has changed the federal tax deduction to include child tax, earned income and dependent care credits. The revised calculations and associated schema are now available. Alabama returns in Ready to Release status will be moved to Stopped for State Schema Change if released on the old schema version. Alabama 1040 returns will need to be recalculated and resubmitted on this release if released on the old schema version. Alabama DOR indicates completed returns electronically filed with the current version of the schema will be automatically recalculated to reflect the new federal tax deduction. Amended returns must be filed if paper filing.

Arizona - Arizona Proposition 208 was struck down as unconstitutional, so the high income surcharge has been revoked for the Arizona Individual tax return. Based on the information provided, no reaction is necessary for taxpayers who have already filed. The surcharge is revoked and the regular tax rate has been restored to the original 4.5%. This means there will be no net difference in tax. Amended returns are not necessary. Arizona DOR indicates that preparers can continue to file returns using existing forms and updated forms will be provided soon. New forms will be incorporated once they are received.

Individual, Corporation, Partnership, and S Corporation

Philadelphia - Philadelphia announced they are disabling their MeF system starting at 6:00 p.m. ET on Friday, April 1, 2022 to activate a new schema version. Program changes are available with this release. Once you update the software and recalculate returns on this new version, you will not be able to upload or release Philadelphia returns until 8:00 p.m. ET on Friday, April 1, 2022 when the new schema is activated by Philadelphia. Any returns calculated, uploaded, and released on a prior release may be filed until 5:45 p.m. ET on Friday, April 1, 2022. After April 1, 2022 at 5:45 p.m. ET, you will need to update to the latest release to electronically file your Philadelphia returns. Any returns in Ready to Release status calculated using the prior version of the schema will be moved to Stopped for State Schema Change.

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Alabama

Alabama has changed the federal tax deduction to include child tax, earned income and dependent care credit. This includes updating the schema used for electronic filing.

Delaware

Charitable mileage deduction is no longer limited to \$0.17 in a few scenarios, but rather is \$0.26 for all scenarios.

Oregon

Preparer signature date on Forms OR-40, OR-40P, and OR-40N will display a valid date.

Philadelphia

The City of Philadelphia is activating new electronic filing specifications on Friday, April 1, 2022 at 8:00 p.m. EDT. You may continue to use the old specifications until 5:45 p.m. EDT on Friday, April 1, 2022. You must update and recalculate all Philadelphia forms on this release to electronic file Forms BIRT, BIRT-EZ, NPT, and SIT again.

Forms BIRT / BIRT-EZ estimates are not prepared if Final Return date is present.

Virginia

Federal return print is not included in the Virginia copy when taxpayer and spouse (if applicable) are filing Form 763S.
