- Employee Benefit Plan - Monday, January 6, 2013
- Corporation, S Corporation, Partnership - Monday, January 13, 2014
- Individual - Friday, January 31, 2014

Form 8959. The following updates have been made for Form 8959:

- An entry of "1" on Wages and Salaries > IRS W-2 > Box 14 code will cause the related amount to flow to Form 8959, Line 14.
- An entry of "2," "3," "4," or "5" on Wages and Salaries > IRS W-2 > Box 14 code will cause the related amount to flow to Form 8959, Line 23.
- Wages and Salaries > IRS W-2 > Medicare tax withheld will include the 0.9% additional Medicare tax on wages paid in excess of \$200,000.
- Form 8959 will not print in the accountant and client copies when not required in the government copy of the return.

Tuition Statement. When opening a return created from a roll forward, filer information will appear on Tuition Statement > IRS 1098-T.
