NEW IN THIS RELEASE

Knowledge-Based Audits of Health Care Entities is designed to help the auditor efficiently and effectively perform financial statement audits of health care entities in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America (GAAS). The knowledge-based audit is a risk-based methodology that emphasizes using knowledge of the entity to assess the risk of material misstatement of the financial statements. This allows the auditor to more appropriately focus audit efforts on those areas which in the auditor's judgment are the most significant and pose the most risk to the financial statement audit. The operations of health care entities are often unique and complex, and require specialized accounting and auditing knowledge. Health care organizations can be for-profit or nonprofit entities. Consideration of the structural makeup of the health care organization is important when customizing the audit plan, performing risk assessments, and developing audit procedures to ensure an effective audit in accordance with GAAS. This module includes up-to-date guidance for auditing health care organizations such as hospitals, skilled nursing facilities, continuing care retirement communities, managed care organizations, home health agencies, and federally qualified health centers.

The 2011 edition of *Knowledge-Based Audits of Health Care Entities* is current through SAS-121, *Revised Applicability of Statement on Auditing Standards, No. 100—Interim Financial Information*, and includes the following updates:

2011 ProSystem fx Knowledge Tools

The **2011 Knowledge Tools** have been updated to take into account new or pending auditing standards and guidance. References to FASB pre-Codification literature have been removed throughout the forms and practice aids. In addition, various practice alerts have been added to address the applicability of new or pending audit standards and guidance to audits of health care entities. The 2011 tools now include links to industry specific guidance that provides instant access to detailed analysis related to the steps and processes discussed in the workpapers. Also included is a revised financial statement disclosures checklist that provides a centralized resource of the required and recommended GAAP disclosures and key presentation items currently in effect, using the style referencing under the FASB Accounting Standards Codification™.

Links to Accounting Research Manager (ARM). If you subscribe to an ARM library that includes audit content, you can now link directly to source material from Resources within Knowledge Tools documents. These links have been updated to reference to the accounting standards under the FASB Accounting Standards Codification.

Knowledge-Based Audit Documents (KBAs)

- **KBA-103 Significant Matters** was updated; the review of management's significant estimates was moved into new **KBA-106 Review of Significant Estimates**.
- **NEW KBA-106 Review of Significant Estimates** was added to aid the auditor in performing the required review and evaluation of management's significant accounting estimates.
- **KBA-400** was revised with updated instructions and tables; a new column was added for indicating whether internal controls over financial reporting were selected for testing operating effectiveness.
- **KBA-502** was revised with updated instructions and tables; a new column was added for indicating whether internal controls over financial reporting were selected for testing operating effectiveness.
- **KBA-901** is current through September 30, 2011, and includes the relevant citation from the FASB Codification as of September 30, 2011, using the FASB classification system.

- **NEW KBA-901J Industry-Specific Disclosures Checklist: Health Care Entities** supplements the General U.S. GAAP Financial Statement Disclosures Checklist and serves as a means to document consideration of the specialized presentation and disclosure requirements for health care entities. KBA-901J reflects guidance through [ASU 2011-05, *Comprehensive Income \(Topic 220\)—Presentation of Comprehensive Income*](#).

Audit Programs (AUDs):

- **AUDs 801 through 819** were updated to include additional industry-specific substantive procedures, as well as control testing steps and new risk summary/linking tables to better document the linkage between risks identified and procedures performed.
- **NEW AUD-823 Audit Program: Share-Based Payments** is designed to help the auditor gain sufficient appropriate audit evidence for risks related to share-based payments.
- **NEW AUD-905 Audit Program: Consideration of Omitted Procedures after the Report Date** is designed to help the auditor consider and address the importance of omitted procedures that may have been necessary at the time of the audit, document procedures performed subsequent to the date of the audit report, determine the appropriate course of action in the circumstances, and document the auditor's conclusions.

Practice Aids (AIDs)

- **NEW AID-703 Control Testwork Template** is designed to help the auditor in performing tests of the operating effectiveness of internal controls.
- **NEW AID-704 Summary Control Testing Plan** is designed to aid in the documentation of the auditor's plan for testing the operating effectiveness of internal controls.

Auditor's Reports (RPTs):

- **RPTs-901–981** were updated throughout to remove references to pre-codification FASB statements and reflect changes in standards, where applicable; also updated or added new practice points addressing clarified standards and added links to the corresponding guide, *Knowledge-Based Audits™ of Health Care Entities*.

Correspondence Documents (CORs)

- **COR-204** has been updated to add “material weakness” to the language of the engagement letter and to provide appropriate verbiage for engagements to report on supplementary information under SAS-119.
- **NEW COR-211 Communication with Predecessor Auditor Prior to Client/Engagement Acceptance** provides a sample letter from successor auditor to predecessor auditor requesting information regarding management's integrity, prior to making the client acceptance decision.
- **NEW COR-212 Request from Client to Predecessor Auditor to Release Information to Successor Auditor** provides a sample letter from client to predecessor auditor asking them to release information and respond to successor auditor inquiries.
- **COR-901** has been updated to reflect language contained in SAS-118, 119, and 120.

Resource Documents (RESs)

- **RES-001** has been updated to provide information regarding the Auditing Standards Board's Clarity Project and, where applicable, to reflect organizational and instructional changes.

Important Roll Forward Information

To ensure that changes made in our documents do not effect the documents' compliance with standards, some information will not roll forward from previous versions. To ensure as much information as possible will roll forward, do not roll forward from the 2010 *Knowledge-Based Audits of Health Care Entities™* to the 2011 *Knowledge-Based Audits of Health Care Entities™* until you have installed the ProSystem *fx* Engagement release 5.7.1 or later. For any title-specific roll forward information, refer to the Help icon found in the Roll Forward Wizard.

Note: While working through your Word documents, it is important to follow certain steps to avoid any data loss upon roll forward. If you save the workpaper before tabbing out of a cell, you risk losing data when rolling forward. If upon roll forward you experience any data loss in a workpaper, do the following:

1. Open the workpaper.
2. Update the problem cell with random text (only after experiencing data loss).
3. Tab out of the cell.
4. Go back into the cell and remove the random text.
5. Tab out of the cell.
6. Save the document.

Important Notes

- Knowledge Coach customers should download and use the Knowledge Coach formatted version of this title that was released and posted to <http://support.cch.com/updates/KnowledgeCoach> in August 2011. This Knowledge Tools title release is not compatible with the Knowledge Coach module. Knowledge Coach customers can still use this Knowledge Tools title, but they will not have Knowledge Coach functionality and integration available in these workpapers.
- A minimum of 1GB of RAM is highly recommended for optimal performance when opening and navigating through ProSystem *fx* Knowledge Tools documents.
- ProSystem *fx* Engagement version 4.9 or later with Knowledge Tools must be installed on the computer in order to install this Knowledge Tools title. Additional requirements include Microsoft Office Professional 2003 SP2 or higher, Microsoft Office 2003 Primary Interop Assemblies (PIA) and Visual Studios 2005 Tools for Office Second Edition Runtime (VSTOR). The installations of PIA and VSTOR can be found on the Engagement CD in the Applications\Knowledge Tools Prerequisites folder.

Installation Instructions

Your Knowledge Tools title will integrate itself directly into ProSystem *fx* Engagement. The only additional system requirement is approximately 75MB of disk space to store your Knowledge Tools program content files. Refer to the ProSystem *fx* Engagement with Knowledge Tools Release Notes for any other system requirements.

Important: The 2011 *Knowledge-Based Audits of Health Care Entities™.msi* allows for mass deployment/installation by way of pushing the install to computers.

How to install:

1. Close all Microsoft programs and ProSystem *fx* Engagement.

Note: If the ProSystem *fx* Engagement Update Utility in Step 2 below has already been applied, proceed with Step 4.

2. Download the ProSystem *fx* Engagement Update Utility.*
3. Download the License Update File here.*

Note: When saving the file be sure to select All Files from the Save as type drop down list.

4. Download the following self-extracting 2011 Knowledge-Based Audits™ of Health Care Entities.exe download file. Download for ProSystem fx Engagement v. 4.9 or higher
5. Save the file to your computer.
6. Double-click the self-extracting .exe.
7. Select Run.
8. Select a destination folder to store the 2011 Knowledge-Based Audits™ of Health Care Entities. msi installation file.
9. Select Install.
10. Enter the password and select OK.

NOTE: The password to extract the installation file can be found on the mailed copy of the release bulletin.

After extracting the 2011 *Knowledge-Based Audits of Health Care Entities*™ msi, do the following to install the Knowledge Tools templates:

1. Double-click on the **2011 Knowledge-Based Audits of Health Care Entities™.msi** to begin the installation.
2. Select **Next** on the Welcome screen.
3. Accept the License Agreement, and then select **Next**.
4. Select the destination location for the templates, and then select **Next**.
5. Review the installation settings, and then select **Install** to begin copying the files.
6. Select **Finish** to complete the installation.

Note: You must add and assign the Knowledge Tools license in ProSystem fx Engagement Administrator before using the workpaper templates.

After the 2011 Knowledge-Based Audits™ of Health Care Entities.msi installation file has been extracted, follow the Installation Instructions included in the Release Bulletin.

ProSystem fx Engagement Update Utility Instructions

If the Knowledge Tools title is not shown in the list of available products in the License Assignment window, the title's licensing information will need to be updated with the ProSystem fx Engagement Update Utility prior to adding the licenses for the title or assigning the licenses to staff members.

To download the utility and update file, do the following:

1. Download the ProSystem fx Engagement Update Utility from the Program Updates/Knowledge Tools Series page of the ProSystem fx Engagement support Web site.
2. Click **ProSystem fx Engagement Update Utility** to download the utility.
3. Click **License Update File** to download the update file (LicenseUpdate.upd).

Note: We recommend you save the files to your computer to run the utility.

After downloading the files, do the following:

1. Close ProSystem *fx* Engagement Administrator and ProSystem *fx* Engagement.
2. Double-click the ProSystem *fx* Engagement Update Utility (**PfxEngUpdateUtility.exe**) file.
3. Enter the login name and password for an authorized ProSystem *fx* Engagement administrator.
4. Browse for or enter the path for the license update file you just downloaded (LicenseUpdate.upd).
5. Click **OK** to update the ProSystem *fx* Engagement database, and add the Knowledge Tools title to the License Assignment window in ProSystem *fx* Engagement Administrator. You may now add and assign the Knowledge Tools title to the users.

After updating the license file in the ProSystem *fx* Engagement Admin module and running the Update License Utility for 4.9 users, licenses need to be assigned to the staff who will use 2011 *Knowledge-Based Audits of Health Care Entities*[™]. If you have not already established a Single Sign-on (SSO) account with Customer Service, we urge you to do so at this time.

Using Your Knowledge Tools Content

Knowledge Tools Workpaper Templates

To use Knowledge Tools Workpaper Templates, do the following:

1. Open a binder in ProSystem *fx* Engagement.
2. Select the workpaper tab into which you would like to insert the workpaper.

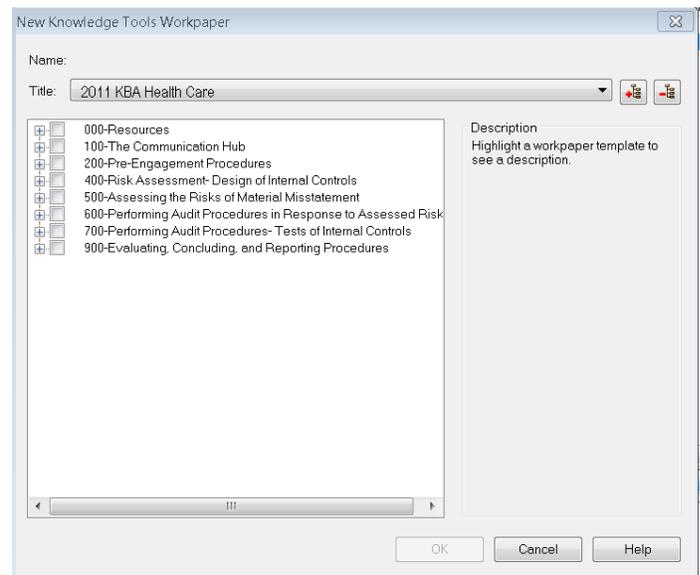


Figure 1 – New Knowledge Tools Workpaper

3. Select **New Knowledge Tools Workpaper** from the toolbar or File menu. The New Knowledge Tools Workpaper window displays (*Figure 1*).
4. Select the New Knowledge Tools Title with the content you would like to use. You can only select titles you have installed. The information displayed changes to reflect the workpaper organization available for the selected title.
5. Select the Knowledge Tools Workpaper Templates to insert into your binder.
6. Click **OK** to display the Selected Workpaper Properties window. Each workpaper name is automatically loaded into the Name field.
7. Add a workpaper index in the Index field and make any needed Name modifications. You can also modify the tab location or the roll forward settings for each workpaper.
8. Click **OK**. The integrated Knowledge Tools workpaper is now inserted into your engagement binder.

Binder Templates

ProSystem *fx* Engagement provides powerful engagement templates with integrated Knowledge Tools content.

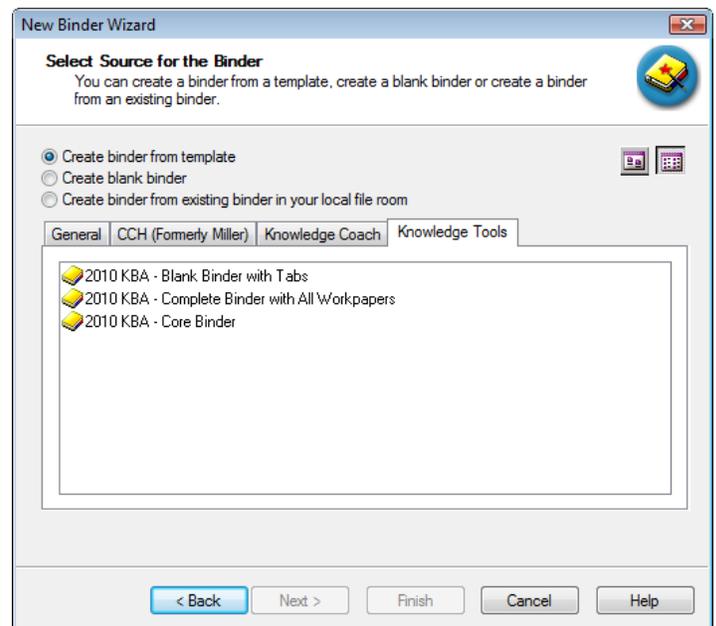


Figure 2 – New Binder Wizard

To start engagements pertaining to your purchased title with a binder template populated with programs and worksheets, select **New Binder Wizard** from either the toolbar or File menu in the File Room window. The New Binder Wizard window displays (*Figure 2*). To set up the binder, do the following:

1. Select **Create binder from template**.
2. Click on the **Knowledge Tools** tab.
3. Select the appropriate binder template for your engagement. You will see binder templates for the Knowledge Tools titles installed.
4. Select **Next**.
5. Complete the binder properties information as needed.
6. Select **Finish**. The new binder displays in the file room. Refer to the ProSystem *fx* Engagement User Guide, accessible from the Help menu in ProSystem *fx* Engagement, for more information.

One binder template contains all workpaper templates from the title, one binder template contains only the core workpaper templates, and the third binder template contains only workpaper tabs using the Knowledge Tools indexing system. This allows you to build your own binder template by populating the tabs with the workpapers of your choice.
