Installing PDFlyer (Standalone)

Installing PDFlyer Server

If PDFlyer Server is currently installed, manually remove the previous version. Install PDFlyer Server to a network drive or shared local drive that is available to all workstations that use PDFlyer.

Microsoft[®] .NET Framework 4.8 must be installed on the server or dedicated workstation running PDFlyer Server. If you have not already installed .NET Framework 4.8, it is installed for you during the installation process.

To install PDFlyer Server, do the following:

- 1. Download PDFlyer_Standalone_20.0.0.12.zip.
- 2. Extract and launch ProSystem fx PDFlyer Server 20.0.0.12.exe.
- 3. Click Next.
- 4. If needed, change the destination folder where PDFlyer Server should be installed by clicking **Browse** and navigating to or entering a new location.
- 5. Click Install. Wait for the installation to complete.
- 6. Select the permission key option for this installation.
- 7. Click Next.
- 8. Click Finish.

Installing PDFlyer

Microsoft[®] .NET Framework 4.8 must be installed on each workstation running PDFlyer. If you have not already installed .NET Framework 4.8, it is installed for you during the installation process.

To install PDFlyer, do the following:

- 1. Browse to \\<computer name>\Workstation.
- 2. Launch ProSystem fx PDFlyer.exe.
- 3. Click Next.
- 4. If needed, change the destination folder where PDFlyer should be installed by clicking **Browse** and navigating to or entering a new location.
- 5. Click Install. Wait for the installation to complete.
- 6. Click Finish.
